#### SCHLOSSBERG HILL WALKING TOUR

"Conquer" the Graz Schlossberg, the city's former fortified hill, via the Schlossbergbahn funicular. Enchanting views and interesting historical insights are sure to leave you in awe. Climb creaking wooden staircases, admire the huge "Liesl" bell and ascend the Clock Tower, listening to the rattling and squeaking of the impressive 300-year old clockwork inside the city's traditional landmark.
